## Curriculum:

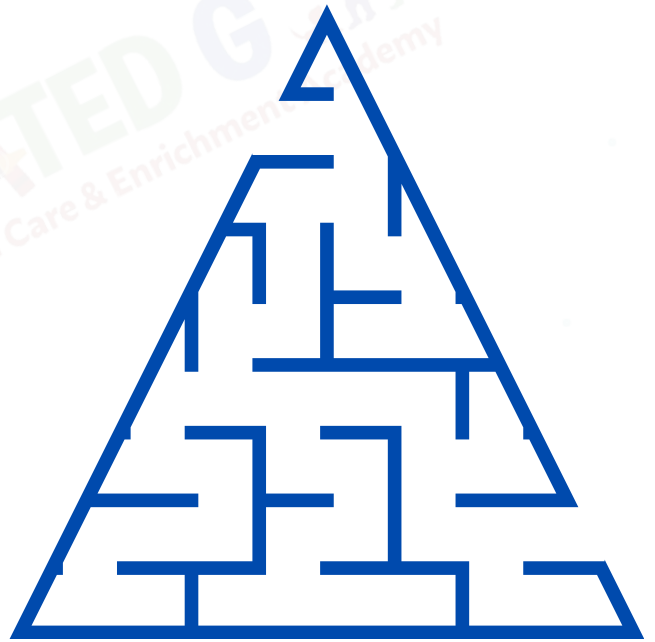
- The curriculum unit plan focuses on "Exploring Nature," providing children with hands-on experiences to develop their understanding and appreciation of the natural world.
